His new name is Pharaoh and his fate – once bleak – is now bright. Thanks to caring friends like you, he will grow into a strikingly handsome lion in his permanent home at PrideRock Wildlife Refuge.

For \$25.00 a family of four can see a first-run movie – minus the buttered popcorn and drinks – but \$25.00 can do so much more.

It's almost impossible to find an adoptive home for a full-grown lion, tiger, or cougar. Zoos are full – no one wants an abandoned big cat. But your donation can help continue to care for and nurture so many deserving animals. From lions to cougars to tigers, you'll make a big difference in their lives.

Lion cubs like Pharaoh are being bred in record numbers. In fact, lion and tiger cubs can be purchased for as little as \$300...off the back of a battered pickup.

And more tigers are kept as "pets" – in trailers, backyards, and basements – than exist in the wild today. A mere 8,000 remain wild: this population has decreased by a staggering 90,000 from just a century ago. And the lion? Hunting, loss of habitat, and lack of food have drastically reduced the African lion population – between 30% and 50% in the past 30 years alone.

The number one cause of lion death in the wild is starvation. Poachers kill tigers to harvest their skin, bones, and claws. Tiger remains fetch up to \$70,000 each.

But PrideRock stepped in to fill a critical void. Situated on 9 acres outside of Dallas, Texas, the pride has grown from 2 cubs to 27 permanent residents. And here's the PrideRock Promise:

# PrideRock will always be a permanent home for big cats

Your generous donation of \$25, \$35, \$50 or more can help them live treasured lives. It will help carry on PrideRock's high standards of maintenance, recreation, and nutrition.

With proper care, big cats can live up to 25 years. That's nearly double their life span in the wild. At just a year and a half old, a tiger will grow to be 300 pounds, require a covered enclosure of at least 20X40X10 for their safety and security, and will eat at least 8-10 pounds of meat.

#### Every day.

Currently, PrideRock's food bill tops \$1,300 each month.

In addition to the daily care and concern of the big cats, PrideRock has several programs underway. Here are two of them:

- ✓ <u>Spaying of females</u> Since PrideRock doesn't permit breeding, the female cats must be spayed. It's especially important in the older cats because their age is a factor in some preventable health problems. The estimated cost of transporting and spaying 17 females is just under \$10,000; and
- ✓ "<u>Tiger River</u>" Tigers <u>LOVE</u> water! In order to keep the cats cool in the Texas heat, PrideRock has installed misters, shade and fans. "Tiger River" will be a shallow pond running through all tiger enclosures for their continued comfort and will cost approximately \$50,000.

Your donation will greatly help PrideRock keep big cats safe and sound. For the rest of their lives.

These strong, regal, courageous creatures were never meant to be domestic pets. Yet that's what happens more and more. Won't you help PrideRock give cats like Pharaoh a safe haven?
